3.	Motions on Notice		
	 a) That BRPS P&C Association authorises expenditure to improve the ventilation in the assembly hall NWL proposed the motion that the P&C fund the \$32,725 in hall ventilation costs. AWR seconded it Quote was discussed. Our Building Committee made up of parents who are architects and engineers have had the quote checked for reasonableness and endorsed it. Voted 8 in favour and 2 against Decision: That P&C fund the Hall Ventilation for \$32,725. 		
	Action: CF to communicate and handover to the Building Committee and also request that the Lead Time in completing this piece of work is reasonable (quote says 6 weeks).		
	 b) That BRPS P&C Association authorises expenditure to refurbish the canteen so that we meet our employer obligations to staff and our obligations as a canteen operator to our students MH proposed the motion that P&C fund up to \$50,000 to refurbish the School Canteen. GW seconded it 3 quotes have been commissioned. It would be cheaper for us to do this ourselves to save on project management costs. Once approved, MH can talk to MM re the floor plan and also identify parents who can help manage the project Unanimously voted in favour 		
	<u>Decision</u> : That P&C will fund up to \$50,000 for Canteen refurbishment costs.		
	Action: MH and MM to discuss and agree the refurbishment plans.		
	Action: MH to progress and project manage the Canteen refurbishment.		
	Action: CF and MM to discuss and agree the Uniform Shop location.
