1. Policy

1.1. The Beaumont Road Public School P&C Association ('BRPS P&C') is committed to providing a safe and healthy workplace for our members, volunteers and employees. BRPS P&C believes that providing a safe and healthy workplace for our members, volunteers and employees is vital to our successful operation.

2. Policy Objectives

2.1. BRPS P&C will commit resources to comply with all the relevant Acts and Regulations to ensure that its workplace is safe.

3. Responsibilities

3.1. Promoting and maintaining Work, Health and Safety (WHS) is the responsibility of any 'person conducting a business or undertaking'. For the purposes of this policy, this means BRPS P&C and any of its sub-committees.

3.2. It is important that all BRPS P&C members, volunteers and employees accept responsibility for the health and well being of all their fellow BRPS P&C members, volunteers and employees.

3.3. All BRPS P&C members, volunteers and employees will promote the concepts of WHS and are required to ensure that, where possible, they are implementing practical measures to ensure that BRPS P&C activities are undertaken in a safe manner without risks to any person's health.

3.4. It is important that BRPS P&C members, volunteers and employees understand that they have a duty to intervene when necessary to promote a safe and healthy workplace.

4. Communication of this policy

4.1. WHS will be addressed at BRPS P&C general meetings on the request of any member in writing or as set on the Agenda by the President or the Secretary.

5. Enactment

5.1. BRPS P&C has adopted this Work, Health & Safety policy at a general meeting of the members on the 10th day of March, 2015.
